FULLY FUNDED NVQ LEVEL 2 AND LEVEL 3

- **First Full Level 2 NVQ for candidates NOT possessing a level 2 qualification**
- **‘Additional’ Full Level 2 NVQ for those candidates who already possess a level 2 qualification**
- **First Level 3 NVQ for learners NOT possessing a first level 2 qualification or above (Level 3 Jumper)**

CO-FUNDED – This training is also fully funded HOWEVER, it is expected that the employer will contribute to the Awarding Body registration and certification costs, price on application

- **First Level 3 qualification for candidates already possessing a Level 2 qualification**
- **‘Additional’ full level 3 NVQ for those learners who already possess a Level 3 qualification**

To qualify for Train To Gain you will need to be

- Age 19 +
 - Have been living in the EU for at least 3 years
 - Must be committed to completing the NVQ in 8 months for level 2 and 12 months for level 3
 - Must be employed, working voluntarily or childminders

- You can start this NVQ programme at any time
 - All assessment and NVQ training will be carried out in your setting by fully qualified and experienced assessors
 - Information advice and guidance is an integral part and will be given at the start and throughout the NVQ training
 - Candidates can also take advantage of our additional Literacy, Numeracy and Skills for Life training

The Government chooses to prioritise its investment in those employees and volunteers **without** the equivalent of 5 GCSE's (Grades A-C) already except where flexibilities exist regarding additional qualifications. Level 2 is deemed to be any qualification of 5 GCSE's grade C or above. If you are unsure if you qualify, please contact me to clarify whether or not you are eligible.
